

Cassia County Noxious Weed Control

The Department has an opening for part time weed sprayers.

Qualifications and Criteria for this job include:

- Must be a High School graduate or GED equivalent.
- Must be at least 18 years old with a current Drivers License.
- Know how to safely drive, operate and maintain a ¾ ton 4x4 diesel pickup while pulling a horse trailer in mountainous terrain.
- Either have or be able to pass the test for a Commercial Applicators License with the Idaho State Department of Ag.
- Be able to take and pass the approved safety training course for operating an ATV & UTV (4-wheeler).
- Know how to ride a horse and handle a pack mule while spraying in rugged mountain terrain in a safe manner.
- Be familiar with Cassia County and the Goose Creek area, and be able to read and follow maps.
- Have good math and computer skills. Know, but not required, Arc View and GPS Pathfinder Office and know how to use GPS Units for collection of weed points.
- Have a basic knowledge of all 67 noxious weeds on the State List and also identify the native plants.

Health:

- Be able to lift 100 pounds.
- Cannot have allergies or asthma that might be triggered by working in highly populated areas of weeds, pollen, wind, dirt, etc.
- Must be able to handle chemicals used for weed control.
- Be willing to work long hours in extreme weather conditions both cold and hot.
