MANDATORY SAFETY PROTOCOLS IN
COURT FACILITIES OF THE FIFTH
JUDICIAL DISTRICT**

**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
2021-35**

Eric J. Wildman, Administrative District Judge of the Fifth Judicial District hereby finds and Orders as follows:

WHEREAS on June 25, 2021 the Idaho Supreme Court issued its Amended Order entitled “EMERGENCY ORDER REGARDING COURT SERVICES.” Said Order contained the following requirements and prohibitions:

2. **Administrative District Judges Authorized to Issue Orders Regarding Courthouse and Courtroom Risk Reduction Protocols in Their Districts:** If, as reflected in [the Weekly Publication of COVID-19 Incidence Rates], a county’s seven-day moving average incidence rate of confirmed or presumed cases of COVID-19 is 25.0 or greater per 100,000 population, the Administrative District Judge shall enter an administrative order defining the safety protocols that will be required in the county’s courthouse. The Order will, at a minimum, require all persons entering the courthouse to do court business to wear a mask that covers the nose and mouth and maintain six feet of social distance from anyone that does not live in their household.

7. **Weekly COVID-19 Incidence Rate Jury Trial Postponements:** Jury proceedings, including jury trials and grand jury proceedings, may commence anytime during a calendar week unless the Administrative District Judge has determined that the County in which the prospective juror has been summoned to attend court has a seven-day moving average incidence rate of confirmed or presumed cases of COVID-19 of 25.0 or greater per 100,000 population as reflected on the Cases by County page of the Idaho Department of Health and Welfare’s COVID-19 Data Dashboard available at <https://coronavirus.idaho.gov>.

WHEREAS, the seven-day moving average incidence rate of confirmed or presumed cases of COVID-19, for Thursday, September 16th, 2021, in the Fifth Judicial District is as follows:

Camas County	129.2
Cassia County	47.6
Gooding County	128.0
Jerome County	109.4
Lincoln County	45.3
Minidoka County	55.7
Twin Falls County	104.7

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. Jury Trials and Grand Jury Proceedings in **Camas, Cassia, Gooding, Jerome, Lincoln, Minidoka and Twin Falls Counties**, are suspended for the week of September 27, 2021.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all persons entering a Court Facility in **Camas, Cassia, Minidoka and Twin Falls** Counties, or a Courtroom or the Court Services Office in **Gooding, Jerome or Lincoln** Counties, to do court business shall be subject to and maintain the following protocols;

2. All persons are required to wear a mask while in a designated court facility, courtroom or court services office on court business.
3. All persons, not of the same household, must observe a minimum of six feet of social distancing from other persons.

This Order is to remain in effect until the seven-day moving average incidence rate in any of the above-mentioned counties falls below 25.0, as determined by the Idaho Department of Health and Welfare.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED.
