The Oakley Recreation District has adopted the following Official Statement: On November 6, 2018, a special election will be held on the question of a levy to provide additional funding for the Oakley Recreation District as provided in Resolution No. 2018-001 of the Oakley Recreation District adopted on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2018. The levy will be assessed per year beginning with the tax year 2019, and it is estimated that eighty-six thousand nine hundred seventy-two dollars and seventeen cents (\$86,972.17) per year (for an effective District levy rate of 0.0006) will be collected each year.

The question to be submitted to the electors of the Oakley Recreation District shall be by ballot reading substantially as follows: Shall the Board of Directors of the Oakley Recreation District be authorized to levy a permanent override levy in the amount of \$86,972.17 (for an effective District levy rate of 0.0006) per year commencing with the fiscal year beginning 2019, for the purpose of paying all lawful expenses as provided in the resolution of the Board of Directors of the Oakley Recreation District adopted on February 7, 2018?
